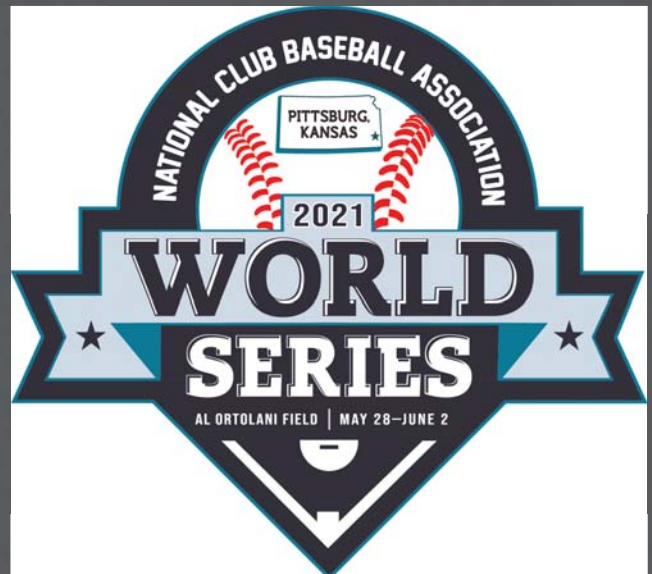
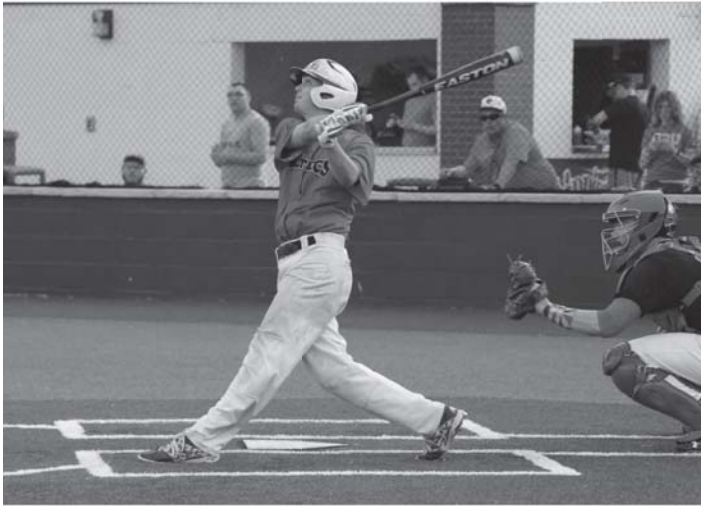

### **RULES OF THE EVENT**





- The event will consist of 3 rounds with 16 participants
- First round: each participant gets 10 outs to hit as many HR's as they can. Six participants moves onto the semi-final round.
- Semi-final round: each participant gets 10 outs to hit as many HR's as they can. Three participants move onto the finals.
- Any homerun hit when the batter has 9 outs are considered "moneyballs" and are with 2 home runs. Moneyballs are available in ALL rounds except sudden death.
- 1st tiebreaker goes to participant with more total HR's in that round moves on. 2nd tiebreaker goes to participant with more total homeruns in the Challenge. 3rd tiebreaker goes to participating with more reg. season HR's. Should none of these tiebreakers be satisfied, both participants will move on.
- In the final round only, should 2 or more participants tie for most "final round HR's", a 4 out "sudden death" will take place.
