

#### 2021-2022 NCBA Rules Committee Meeting Results (Last Year)

- Suspending DI & DII rule 1.01.2, which requires all fall eligible teams to schedule at least 1 conference series in the fall:
   PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0
- Modify rule 7.08.0 to increase the age limit you must enroll full time by from 25 to 26: **PASSES: 5 VOTES TO 2**
- If you final year of eligibility was interrupted by COVID in the 19/20 or 20/21 season, you can apply for an extra year of eligibility to be used in the 21/22 season: PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0
- DI ONLY: Suspend the \$300 increase in performance bond (\$300 to \$600) during the 21/22 season: PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0
- DII ONLY: Courtesy runner are allowed for the catcher with any outs in an inning: PASSES: 5 VOTES TO 2
- DII ONLY: For the 22/23 DII Season, dropping courtesy runners completely: PASSES: 5 VOTES TO 2
- DII ONLY: Allowing reentry for all starting players at the DII level: PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0



### 2021-2022 NCBA Rules Committee Meeting Results (Last Year)

- Continue suspension of requiring DI & DII rule 3.01.2, requiring DI & DII teams to play so many non-conference game(s) to be eligible for the postseason: PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0
- Continue DI & DII rule 6.05.2, stating if a team who has reached it's 33 man roster max & has a player test positive for COVID, that player can be removed temporarily & return at a later date. Upon return, the replacement player must be removed:
   PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0
- Updating definition of professional experience to, "professional experience is defined as earning compensation to paly the sport
  of baseball (name, image likeness earnings are excluded)": PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0

## 2022 DII Regional Playoffs

- 8 Regional Playoffs in 2022
  - All 8 at Neutral Site (Always open to recommendations)
  - 4 team, double elimination
- ONCBA covers field costs, game balls and umpires
- Iteams receive:
  - Discounted hotels
  - Championship Plaques
  - Opportunity to play post-season baseball
  - Opportunity to compete for Regional Championship and eventually National Championship





The 2022-2023 NCBA Season will feature Division I, Division II & the return of Division III. Division III was first implemented for the 2017-2018 season though was temporarily suspended prior to the 2020-2021 season.

#### **Division I**

• Division I alignment should see little to no movement compared to the 21-22 season.

• 129 Division I Teams have already submitted their renewal paperwork (132 last season)

#### **Division II**

With Division III opening back up in the Midwest & New England areas, several Division II teams from the 21-22 season will be explored to move down to Division III.

• Majority of returning Division II teams from the 21-22 season will remain in Division II for the 22-23 season.

#### **Division III**

All brand new teams joining the NCBA will be placed in Division III should they be located in an area that Division III be available – should they be located in an area without Division III, they'll be placed in Division II.

• Division III conferences will consist of brand new NCBA teams along with former Division II member teams from the 21-22 season.

#### **NOTES**

Any teams without their paperwork submitted are risking being left out for 22/23 season.

• Realignment meetings are taking place now

## NCBA Rules Committee

©Committee met on July 23rd to discuss, debate, vote, and establish any changes to the NCBA rules

Teams communicated their proposed rule changes via a Rule Change Suggestion Form

All rules suggestions were discussed, however, not all rule suggestions received enough support to warrant a vote.



#### **2022-2023 NCBA Rules Committee Meeting Results**

- > All stats from prior weeks games must be submitted by midnight of the following Thursday: **PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0**
- > Any team found intentionally uploading inaccurate stats will be subject to possible disciplinary action: PASSES: 6 VOTES TO 1
- Reverse previous rule 1.01.2 stating all fall eligible teams are again required to be scheduled one conference series in the fall: PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0
- Remove rule 7.09.03, which covers COVID waivers players could apply for if their final year of NCBA eligibility was taken from them due to their not being cleared to compete due to COVID related circumstances : PASSES: 5 VOTES TO 2
- > Add subset to 4.00.0: NCAA pace of play rules will be enforced after a warning is issued by umpire: **PASSES: 5 VOTES TO 2**
- > Modify rule 23.02.1 to add "including but not limited to chirping, trash talking, razing & verbal abuse: PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0
- Modify rule 7.03.0 to be more specific into detailing what constitutes as a satellite campus & create rule 7.03.1.2 stating "Bridge Programs do not qualify as satellite campuses: PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0
- Modify rule 3.01 to allow more clarity on 3 way ties. Modify 3.01.4 to state "conference winning percentage vs. all tied teams & create 3.01.10 to state "one tiebreaker eliminates a team from consideration or determines a conference champion, the tiebreaker process starts over: PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0



#### **2022-2023 NCBA Rules Committee Meeting Results**

- Modify rule 4.04.1.2 to add exception stating all games played within the same round of the Playoff will be scheduled for the same length (DI only as all DII & DIII games are 7 innings) : PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0
- > The #1 seed within any Regional/District Playoff gets 1<sup>st</sup> choice of game time on Day 1: **PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0**
- > Modify rule 5.04 requiring the lineup card to list a players (or initial), last name and number being worn: **PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0**
- > Modify rule 17.01.0 to bold and underline "only for the pitcher": **PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0**
- Modify rule 31.03.3 to allow teams in the Northern Pacific East Conference to be eligible to play NCBA Sanctioned Games in the fall: PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0
- > DII ONLY Reversing rule 18.05.0 to continue to allow courtesy runners for the catcher: PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0
- > DII ONLY Reversing rule 16.01.0 to continue to allow re-entry for starters: **PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0**
- Reverse DI & DII rule 3.01.2 to now mandate the play of non-conference game(s) to be eligible for the postseason: PASSES: 7 VOTES TO 0

Team Operations – Jimmy Henderson

#### In DI, DII and DIII League Participation Agreement (LPA) Form

- New Team Form (Due Date: July 1<sup>st</sup>)
- Existing Team Renewal Form (Due Date: July 1<sup>st</sup>)
- Signed by president of team, signed by club sports director or faculty advisor
- Fax or scan and email to NCBA
- Your ticket to being a participating member of the league

### In Registration Form

- Provides full contact info to NCBA front office
- Complete in full and email to NCBA
- Important to include a secondary contact, Team Email and Head Coach if applicable
- Important to include advisor contact info

### Session 1

- Scheduling Request Form
  - Used to complete Conference Schedule
  - Important to complete with as much detail as possible
  - District Coordinator/Regional Director will assign due date
  - Important to include requests for Spring Break, Finals, and Field Availability
  - The more flexibility the better
- General Liability Insurance
  - \$3,000,000 General Aggregate
  - \$2,000,000 Per Occurrence
  - Policy covers the NCBA and it's members (The Teams)
  - Covers many aspects of NCBA play (i.e. Travel, Practice, Workouts, Games, World Series)
  - Full Year of Coverage
  - This policy assists teams in obtaining playing fields
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Parties can be additionally insured for \$75
  - This policy helped protect the NCBA and it's members from potential financial losses from lawsuits
  - This is NOT a health or accident insurance policy



### Team Operations – Jimmy Henderson

- Reserving Fields
  - DON'T PROCRASTINATE
  - Contact opponents once schedule is released to set dates and times
  - Don't wait till a week before you are to play
  - Reserve fields as soon as schedule is released
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> party additional insured

### Scheduling Umpires

- Contact local High school AD to gain contact info for local umpire assignor
- 2 High school certified (or better) umpires per game
- Don't wait till a week before you are to play
- Contact assignor as soon as schedule is released
- Re-confirm once dates and times are set



Team Operations –Jimmy Henderson

- Iteam Manager Access & Online Player Registration
  - At the beginning of each year, the "Team Manager" will need to request Team Manager access from the NCBA.
  - NCBA will give individual Team Manager Access which will allow the Team Manager to access the Team Code, view the Registration Queue and have other access that players do not have (updating Team Information).
  - Individual Players register by either choosing "Existing User/Returning Login" or "First Time Player Registration" in the "Login" tab of the NCBA DI, DII or DIII sites (DI Teams Register on DI NCBA website, DII Teams Register on DII NCBA Website, etc.)
  - Players will receive a TEAM CODE for their team to begin the player registration
  - <u>**Players**</u> fill out information which determines eligibility
  - Once completed, players will be put in a "Registration Queue"
  - Players able to log back in to upload a picture, bio and change certain information such as jersey number and position.



- Coaches Participation Waivers
  - For non-playing coaches, managers, trainers, etc.
  - MUST be typed, printed, SIGNED, then faxed or scan and emailed
  - Coaches, managers, trainers, are NOT allowed on the field or in the dugouts unless they have a waiver on file with the NCBA
  - Found under "Info" tab of NCBA websites



- Academic Eligibility Letter
  - 2 Sample formats available under "Info" tab of NCBA websites
  - Must be signed by registrar, faculty advisor, or club sports director
  - Can be faxed or scanned and emailed to NCBA Front Office
  - Must be sent directly to NCBA by Club Sports Director or Faculty Advisor unless the letter features an official university registrar stamp.
  - Must show currently enrolled, 12+ credits (9+ for 2 year schools), 2.0+ GPA, no academic warning, and no academic probation
  - Once received by NCBA, players listed on AEL and listed in the Registration Queue, will be added to official NCBA roster
- Uploading player stats and team information
  - Once players are cleared by the NCBA as eligible and appear on the website roster, Team Managers may upload stats for those players
  - Team Managers can login with their credentials (email and password) and will have ability to upload stats and other team information.
  - Instructions on how to upload the stats and other team information will be sent once Login and Password are requested
  - Teams are responsible for uploading their own stats
  - It is the responsibility of the team to be sure that stats are entered accurately and in a timely fashion
  - For Division I and II Teams, ENTIRE stat line must be uploaded in order to earn POW/PIW awards

#### Team Operations – Jimmy Henderson

- Weekly Team Submission Form
  - Submit to Regional Director/District Coordinator by midnight each Monday regardless if games were played the previous week
  - Be sure to enter scores/results for ALL games played during that week
  - Be sure to submit a full stat line when nominating player/pitcher of the week candidates
  - Submit these on time to assure that your candidates receive consideration for awards

#### ONCBA Dues

- 1 BBCOR Certified Bat, 6 Dozen Official NCBA game balls for DI Teams and 5 dozen for DII, \$2 Million general liability insurance
- NCBA DI and DII Teams also get full set of Catchers Gear OR 8 Batting Helmets
- NCBA DI and DII teams will submit a refundable \$300 performance bond due by Sept 15. Teams do not need to send in Performance Bond each year. This is rolled over from year to year.
- \$2,160 (DI), \$1,905 (DII) & \$1,650 (DIII) due in full by February 28<sup>th</sup>
- \$100 discount if paid in full by December 31<sup>st</sup>
- Credit Cards accepted but subject to online handling fee

#### Obsting team interest

- Student involvement fair for incoming freshmen
- Advertisement in school paper
- Flyers in freshmen dorms and common areas
- Coverage in school paper
- Create a Facebook group and other social media groups
- Make presence known on campus

#### Isource Boosting Team Morale

- Get the team together off the field as much as on
- Social events and group activities where ALL are included can build strong bonds which will lead to more success on the field
- Spring Training trips build strong team chemistry
- Set room assignments on the road to break up "Clicks"
- Looking good can make players buy in to the club philosophy faster
  - Coordinating hats, helmets, uniforms, and practice gear go a long way
- Being organized will give opponents the impression of strong leadership while instilling pride in your team to compete with confidence
  - Arriving in uniform, team vans, choreographed warm ups, show opponents that you take things seriously
  - Choreographed practices with a set practice attire sends that same message to your players



- Objective
  Budgeting
  - Very important to set accurate budget
  - Make sure to include Expenses such as umpires, field costs, uniforms, hats, equipment, travel expenses, league dues etc.
  - Income items such as player dues, fundraisers, donations, school input, etc
  - BUDGET FOR POST-SEASON TOURNAMENTS EVERY YEAR!
- In Player Dues
  - How much to charge?
  - What is included?
    - Spring Training trip? Travel costs? New Uniforms?
    - More included = Higher Dues\$
  - Supply & Demand: Lots of interest = Higher Dues
  - Make them pay as soon as they make the team
    - Players who practice for months and then fail to hand over a check hurt the team financially and chemistry
  - Charge \$5 for tryouts



- ① Team Equipment/Uniforms
  - Be sure to order early as customized items tend to have extended lead times
  - Order extra caps, everyone's dad and brother will buy one for a fundraiser
  - Order extra pants and jerseys, uniforms do rip or go missing on occasion
  - Order extra game balls when the supply runs low, NCBA rules state you must use the Official NCBA Baseball
  - Get quotes from NCBA sponsors, there is a reason why the NCBA endorses them
  - Take advantage of additional NCBA discounts during early ordering periods


