Disciplinary Action November 7th, 2023

An individual close to the Minnesota State University - Mankato Club Baseball program notified the NCBA Front Office they believed an ineligible player was participating in NCBA Sanctioned Games this fall.

Upon investigating the claim with the team & their Club Sports administration on campus, it was confirmed that an ineligible player was participating with the team this fall during NCBA Sanctioned Games. The player in question was not on the team's active NCBA roster, as he graduated prior to this 2023/24 NCBA season. The team allowed him to play under a completely different name, that name being of a player who is eligible & currently listed on their active NCBA roster. In doing so, the team's blatant disregard for NCBA rules comes with the following repercussions:

- All game(s) the player in question competed in this fall that resulted in win(s) for Mankato will be reversed to a forfeit loss against the club.
- The player in question will forfeit any remaining NCBA eligibility & will be banned from holding any officer or coaching positions with any NCBA member team.
- Mankato's President will be suspended for his teams next three NCBA Sanctioned Games. He may not compete as a player, coach, or manager due to his involvement in the incident.
